**WINDSHAKER RIDGE - WINE MAKING**

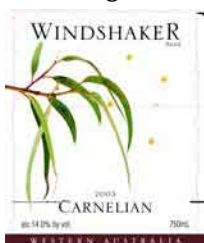
1. To make the best wine you need a thorough understanding of that specific grapes idiosyncrasies.
